Terms

The handler agrees to provide handling services for the above client subject to the following terms:

1. In the event of ring conflicts, dogs will be shown in the order in which handler has taken them on. Handler agrees to find a handler to replace her where necessary.
2. At this time, no client dogs are to be in the handler's private care at any time other than at the show and/ or handling classes. Clients are responsible for ringside pickup unless other arrangements have been made prior to the scheduled day of travel to any show. Since the handler has no client dogs in her private care at this time other than at the shows, payment is expected prior to the last day of showing. If this is not possible, arrangements can be made and must be in writing signed by both parties. An invoice will be created and sent to owner and must be paid by the date stated on the invoice. An invoice is created for all clients and both, handler and owner will receive a copy.
3. Touch up's and touch up trimming are available at no additional cost. Should additional brushing or grooming need to be done because of mats or an un-bathed dog, an additional fee will be placed on the customer invoice.

4. The client agrees that any cash awards will be kept by the handler. All ribbons and non-cash prizes will be given to the client upon return of the dog.

5. Client understands that handler has her personal dogs which are also show dogs. Should ring conflicts arise, the paying clients dogs will be shown first. Handler agrees that a handler will be found to take dogs in, if ring conflicts arise. No dog should be marked absent unless there is no alternative available.

6. All dogs, including those of which the handler owns, are required to be up to date on all vaccinations, including Bordatella. This ensures safety for both the client's dog and the handlers. Certificate of these vaccinations are available to both the client and the handler upon request.

7. Should the client cancel handlers service after the date of closing of entries, the client will be responsible for handling fees including traveling expenses if handler is traveling to show with other client dogs.
